RULES TO LIVE BY

Failure to read and understand your machine's Operator's Manual could result in personal injury or equipment damage.



Tips for staying alive on the job site

Observe safety signs and follow machine's Operator's Manual.

Giving rides can take lives. Don't give in to peer pressure. Just say "no".

Prevent Fires. Keep the machine free of debris during and after each use.

Never operate an unfamiliar machine. Learn how to properly operate machinery.

Keep shields in place and safety devices working; Stay away from moving parts. Click-it, in case you flip it.
If your machine is equipped with a roll over protective structure (ROPS) the seat belt should be used at all times.

Walk around your machine before start up and check for bystanders.

Prevent run-overs. Never by-pass start the engine. Always start machine from the seat.

Always place machine in the park position before leaving operating station. Park machines with the bucket or other attachments on the ground.
